TRENTHAM IN JULY

Rainfall 121.0mm Av 130.3mm Mean max. 7.7°C Av 7.6°C Mean min 2.4°C Av 2.1

NEAR AVERAGE

Temperatures were slightly above and rainfall 93% of normal for July. In contrast to June, frost occurred on 8 nights and only one was severe, -4.7° on 21st. Rain was mostly light and well distributed with best falls on 1st and 15th-18th. These were still insufficient to cause normal seasonal runoff. thunderstorm between Spring Hill and Fern Hill on 23rd produced a complete cover of small hail just west of Tylden and up to 37mm of rain in less than 2 hours. There were no significant wintry spells or other events. Rainfall for the year so far is 27% down on average.
